2. Introduction

The meeting of the Transmission, Access, and Optical Systems (TAOS) Technical Committee (TC) was held in rooms 404 and 405 on the fourth floor of the Hilton Atlanta Hotel, Atlanta, Georgia, during the IEEE Globecom 2013 conference. The Chair Tarek El-Bawab welcomed all participants and outlined the agenda. First, attendants were introduced. The attached slides were displayed as participants went through discussions, item by item.

3. Approval of the ICC 2013 Minutes

Ahmed made a motion to approve the minutes, the draft of which are posted on TAOS website (www.comsoc.org/~taos). The motion was seconded by Wai Pang. All attendees voted to approve the minutes, and the motion passed.

4. New Officers

Tarek explained that no elections were originally planned for this year. However, Mike Devetsikiotis has decided to step down as Vice Chair of TAOS because he is accepting another ComSoc position which will take a lot of his time/effort and because that position has potential conflict of interest (COI) with his TAOS' role. Therefore, Ahmed Kamal is elevated to TAOS Vice Chair. Athanassios Manikas has been nominated by TAOS' Steering Committee, per the TC's Policies and Procedures (P&P), for the position of TAOS Secretary, effective January 1, 2014. Stefano Bregni, as representative of TAOS' Steering Committee, administered the voting process on this nomination. The result of the vote came as follows:

18 Yes (all members who attended the vote), 0 No, and 0 Abstain. Athanassios Manikas will assume the TAOS secretary's position starting January 1, 2014.

An Industry liaison position is also introduced, and Filipo Cuigini is selected to fill this position. One of the main responsibilities of this position will be the creation of a Semi-annual TAOS Newsletter to be published before TAOS ICC and Globecom meetings.

5. Other Highlights and Trends

Tarek updated the attendees about the 2013 TC certification process, in which TAOS is included. He reported that the feedback on TAOS' certification report was positive. The Board of Governors is expected to approve the recertification decision during its IEEE Globecom 2013 conference (before it becomes official). Issues that came up for all TCs to observe in future are

related to P&P continuous update and publications and to defining the TC's Active (Voting) Member. These matters are discussed in more detail later in this meeting.

TAOS current themes (Broadband Access and Green Communication/Networks) continue. The two SAC Tracks in these areas became inherent part of all ICC/GC SAC Symposia

6. Conference updates

Tarek reviewed conferences sponsorships, as per the attached slides, including

- a. Submission and acceptance statistics for ICC'13 and GC'13; and submission statistics for ICC'14. This is concerning the Optical Networking and Systems (ONS) Symposium; and both the "Access Networks and System" Track and the "Green Communication Systems and Networks" Track of the Selected Areas on Communications (SAC) Symposium. The statistics are available on Slides # 7, 8 and 9.
- b. ONS and SAC submission trends (2010 through today)- Slide # 10:
 - i. ONS experience decline in the number of submissions
 - ii. The SAC Tracks are stable, with the Green Communications/Networks Track actually dominating the Symposium
- b. TAOS' SAC Tracks and ONS paper types- Slides # 11 and 12
 - Access Track papers distribution among various broad-band-access areas (based on transmission media types)
 - ii. Systems versus Networking paper in ONS. Tarek explained that system papers have increased in percentage from 25% at GC 2010 to almost 50% at GC 2013. Once again, a discussion took place among attendees about why ONS submissions, especially in networking, have decreased.
- c. Other upcoming ICC/GC sponsorships and conferences which TAOS is technically Co-Sponsoring (TCS)- Slides 13 and 14

7. TAOS P&P

The following has been decided based on recertification-process feedback (Slide # 15):

- a. Since P&P continuous update are desirable by ComSoc and TAC, members of the TAOS community are all invited to provide their P&P suggestions to TAOS officer(s) within 10 days of today. Current P&P are posted on TAOS website: http://committees.comsoc.org/taos/policies_and_procedures.html. Suggestions are welcome through Dec. 20, 2013.
- b. Voting members= active members; who have been attending TAOS meetings in past years. The ComSoc P&P will be used for guidance in this regards; and all suggestion thereto are welcome (per item 7a here above)

8. Other Activities/Updates



Conferences Update (1/8) ICC 2013 (Budapest, Hungary)

- SAC Access Track, chaired by M. Peeters, received 13 papers, 6 accepted (46.2%)
- SAC GCSN, chaired by A. Manikas, received 105 papers, 41 accepted (39%)
- ONS Symposium, co-chaired by F. Callegati, received 78 papers, 48 in networks and 30 in systems. 31 accepted (39.7%)
 Green Track papers constitute 42.7% of SAC's accepted papers, Access Track papers distribution in table below. Other details and statistics were presented in Budapest

Conferences Update (2/8) GC 2013 (Atlanta, Georgia)

- SAC Symposium: 1105 authors: 41.6% from Asia/Pacific; 30.3 from Europe, Middle East, and Africa; 25.5% for NA (20.3% US); and 2.5% from Latin America
- SAC Access Track, chaired by Filippo Cugini, received 30 papers, 11 accepted (36.7%), 3.4 reviewers per paper (statistics below) SAC GCSN, co-chaired by Stefano Bregni, received 92 papers out of which 36 accepted (39%)
- ONS Symposium, co-chaired by S. J. Ben Yoo: received 63 papers, 50.6% in systems and 49.4% in networks. 24 papers accepted, roughly 12 in systems and 12 in networks


Conferences Update (3/8) ICC 2014 (Sydney, Australia)


- SAC Symposium: Access Track, chaired by Tarek El-Bawab, received 18 papers, 4-5 reviewers per paper, submission statistics below

- Papers selection process not completed yet for ICC 2014


